#### **Definitions**

For the purposes of this Cookies Policy:

- Company (referred to as "ReguTrust," "We," "Us," or "Our" in this Cookies Policy) refers to A to Z Education Ltd. ReguTrust is a trade mark belonging to A to Z Education Ltd and is not a limited company. #### 1. Necessary / Essential Cookies

Type: Session CookiesAdministered by: Us

• **Purpose:** These cookies are essential for providing services available through the website and enabling key functionalities, such as user authentication and security. Without these cookies, certain features cannot function properly.

#### 2. Functionality Cookies

Type: Persistent CookiesAdministered by: Us

• **Purpose:** These cookies allow us to remember choices you make when using the website, such as language preferences and login details. This enhances your experience by preventing the need to re-enter information every time you visit the website.
